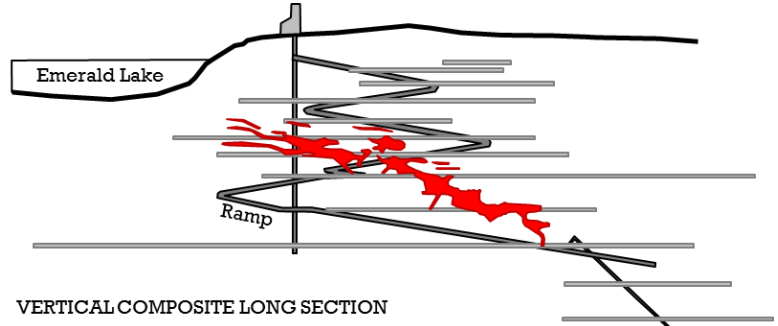
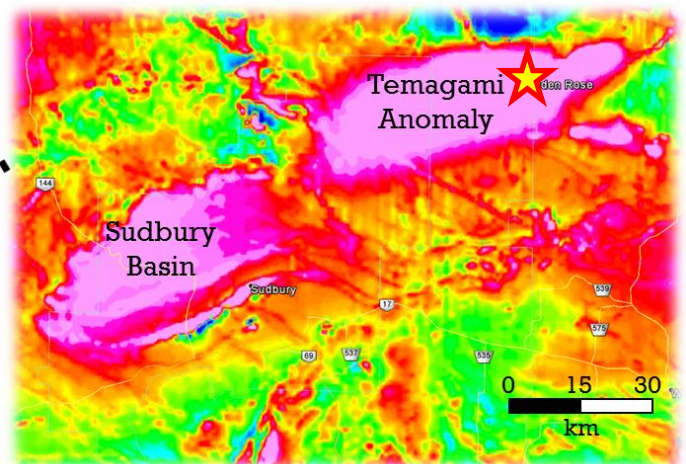
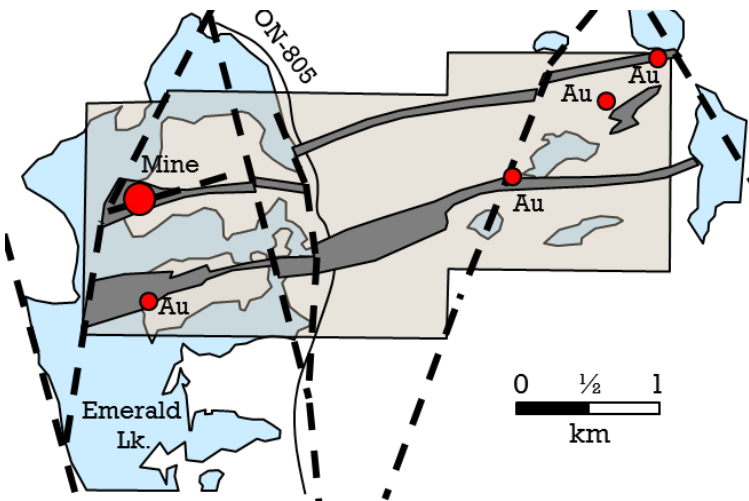


CONQUEST'S GOLDEN ROSE PROPERTY, ONTARIO
